### TOURNAMENT REPORTS

#### LASSWADE WA COMBINED ROUND (UKRS) (1200) – OCTOBER 22<sup>ND</sup> 2017

This round is the first of five shoots taking place at Lasswade until March 2018. For those members who don't know what this round involves, here are the details.

All archers take part shoot over two sessions. The morning session involves shooting 5 dozen arrows from 25metres at a 60cm Portsmouth Target Face with Compound archers shooting at a 60cm 3 Spot Vertical Target Face.

The afternoon session is another 5 dozen arrows with one major change. All archers move down to 18 metres and all the appropriate targets faces are replaced with 40cm versions. Finally, when the shoot is completed, the scores from both sessions are added together to give a combined score for the results.

Eleven members from Lasswade took part this year with three members taking classification awards. Results as follows:

## OUTDOOR CLUB FROSTBITE – ROUND 1 – SATURDAY OCTOBER 28<sup>th</sup> 2017

A new innovation suggested and organised by Joan.

On an experimental basis, you can now shoot outdoors at Grove on the last Saturday of each month from 10am til 12pm.

To spice things up a bit, a modified Frostbite Round is shot. This is a round in which any member can take part in and the details for the Frostbite Round are as follows:

3 dozen arrows shot from 30 metres at a 122cm target face with a maximum score of 360. Unless the weather is particularly severe, then it is un-likely you will be frostbitten!

The first tournament to be held on a Saturday with the Club session having to be cancelled. This meant that we had to be in by 8am to get the range set up for 9.30am. Thanks to our members who were shooting in the morning who helped to get the range set up and to Elayne and Norrie McLean of Penicuik Archers.

The Portsmouth Round is the round many of you will be familiar with. Five dozen arrows shot from 20 yards at a 60cm target face and again, compound archers shoot at a 3 Spot Vertical target face.

Un-like the Combined round shot in October, there are two separate sessions in the morning and the afternoon. If space permits, then an archer can request to shot both sessions as some Lasswade members and visitors did on the day. However, if using this option, only the morning session scores are used for the final results.
